Chris Barron, Executive Director of Population Health and Clinical Services, Fort Healthcare

Chris talked about the work that Fort Healthcare is doing to identify and address health disparities. One resource is the Wisconsin Collaboration for Healthcare Quality, which helps healthcare organizations measure progress towards certain health outcomes. Disparities report is here: <https://www.wchq.org/disparities.php>. FHC uses the PRAPARE tool with patients to identify assets and risks that align with the social determinants of health.

Tyler Prickette, Clinical Pharmacist, Fort Healthcare (FHC)

Tyler gave a presentation (see attached PowerPoint slides) about the Opioid Stewardship Project, which is being piloted at FHC to identify optimal uses of opioid and other pain medications for pain management.

Tracking In Kind Donations to Coalition

Craig reminded members that matching funds are needed for the Drug Free Communities Grant. Match can include in kind donations of time and resources that members put towards the work of the coalition. He asked members for their input on ways to make documentation of match easier and more convenient.
